

**BOOK:** This is Captain America

**AUTHOR:** Brooke Dworkin

**ACTIVITY:** Create Cap's shield

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Cut out a circle from your cardboard box. (I)
- (2.) Use colored paper to create the shapes for the shield.



Using white paper, cut out a star. Make sure it is not bigger than your cardboard circle.



Put the star on blue paper and draw a circle a round the star. Cut out the blue circle. Glue together.



Draw a circle on red paper wider than the blue circle's edge. Cut out red circle. Glue together.




Draw a circle on white paper wider than the red circle's edge. Cut out white circle. Glue together.

Draw a circle on red paper wider than the white circle's edge. Cut out red circle. Glue together.

- Let your paper shield dry.
- Glue your paper shield to your cardboard circle. Cut off any excess cardboard.
- (5.) For arm straps, take two strips of fabric and glue the edges together in a loop. Now glue them to the back side of the shield. You can also use leftover pieces of cardboard. Attach with glue or duct tape.
