

BOOK: Winnie-the-Pooh


ACTIVITY: Make A Winnie the Pooh plush

INSTRUCTIONS:

- (I) Draw an oval (Pooh's head) on yellow fabric. Layer another piece of yellow fabric underneath and cut out your oval on both pieces.
- ② Glue the two pieces together around the sides (adult assistance required). Leave a gap for stuffing.
- 3. Let dry and flip inside out. Your seams are now on the inside.
- Use Stuff Pooh's head using the gap you left. Seal your gap with hot glue. First fold the edges under to create a nice seam.
- Make sure there are no holes. If there are, fix them with the hot glue gun.
- 6. With the leftover yellow felt make the ears. Draw a small circle for the ear shape. Layer 4 pieces of fabric and cut out the shape so you have 4 circles.
- 7. Repeat the gluing process used for the head on each ear. Remember to leave a gap for stuffing.
- 8. Let dry and flip both ears inside out. Fill with stuffing and seal ears with hot glue gun.
- Glue the bottom of the ears onto the head.
- Out out the eyes and nose from brown felt. Cut thin lines of brown felt for the facial expressions. Glue on the face to finish your Pooh plush.

SUPPLIES:

- Yellow felt/fabric
- Brown felt/fabric
- Hot glue gun (adult assistance required)
- Cotton/wool/stuffing material
- Scissors
