Penguin in Winter Wonderland



What's in the Craft Kit:

Template with cute penguins
Coffee Filter Paper
Cotton balls
Blue paper
1 Bottle cap

What you will need at home:

Glue Scissors Color pencils/markers Glitter (optional)

Instructions

(Look at the example photo for reference, it will help with the steps)

Winter Wonderland:

Fold the blue paper in half.

On one half, glue on some cotton balls (fluff them out a bit first).

Draw some mountains on the coffee filter paper. Scrunch it up. Cut out the mountains.

Glue on the mountains on the side of blue paper that is standing.

Behind the mountains, you can either draw or paint stars or glue on some glitter.

Rocking Penguin:

Cut out the two penguins. Make each separately.

Glue each penguin back to back.

Put some glue inside the bottle cap.

Place half a cotton ball in the lower half of the cap.

Put glue on top and attach the penguin to it.

Now place your penguin in your beautiful winter wonderland!
