



Beans, Noodles, Pebbles, Buttons etc.

Scissors

Instructions:

- 1. Trace your hand on the paper in the space below.

- 3. Put two lines of glue on your fish.
- 4. Put your beans or buttons on the lines of glue to look like fish scales.
- 5. Let the glue dry.
- 6. Cut out your hand fish.
