




You will need: Scissors Glue stick Markers

Instructions:

- 1. Print this page.
- 2. Trace your hand on the blank side of the print-out. This will be the body of your bird.
- 3. Draw the eye on the bird and color the bird's body, beak and feet.
- 4. Cut out the beak, feet and body of your bird.
- 5. Glue the beak and feet onto the body of the bird.
