but he didn't catch me!

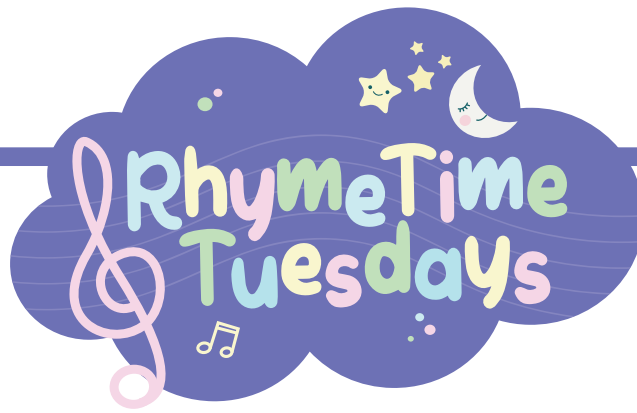

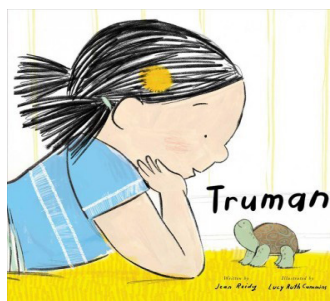

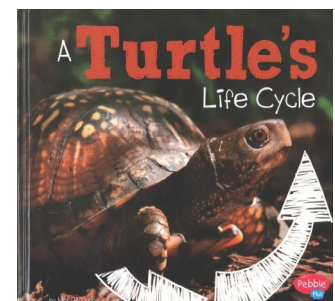

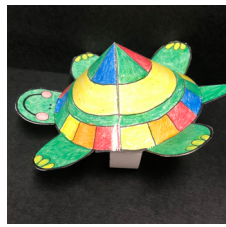
A Turtle's Life Cycle

CRAFT

You will need:

Glue or tape
Markers or Crayons
Scissors



Instructions:

1. Print this page and color the turtle shape.
2. Cut the turtle on the black lines with the head, tail, legs, back and tab all in one piece.
3. Fold on the dotted lines. Gently shape the turtle's shell like a cone.
4. Tape or glue the tab under the back part of the shell.
5. Add glue or tape on each end of the hand strap, and attach it to the underside of your puppet. Now you can hold your turtle puppet.
