



Craft


You will need:

Glue or tape
Markers or Crayons
Scissors

Instructions:

1. Color the kittens, the pies and mittens.
2. Cut out the kittens in one piece on the black line.
3. Cut out the mittens on the black lines.
4. Fold the kittens back along the dotted lines.
5. Fold the pies up along the dotted lines.
6. Tape or glue the tab behind the kitten.

The kittens can stand up!
