





You will need: You will need:


Glue or tape
Markers or Crayons
Scissors

Instructions:

- 1. Color the kittens, the pies and mittens.
- 2. Cut out the kittens in one piece on the black line.
- 3. Cut out the mittens on the black lines.
- 4. Fold the kittens back along the dotted lines.
- 5. Fold the pies up along the dotted lines.
- 6. Tape or glue the tab behind the kitten.
