




Twinkle Twinkle Little Star

You will find the printable Craft and instructions on page 3. If you prefer, come to the library and will give you a packet of the entire Rhyme Time Tuesdays activities to take home.











You will need:

paper

Crayons, colored pencils or markers Scissors

Tape

Ribbon

Crepe paper

Dowel rod, popsicle stick or straw

Instructions:

- 1. Print and color your star
- 2. Cut out star
- 3. Decorate dowel rod, popsicle stick or straw with crepe paper
- 4. Tape star to dowel rod, popsicle stick or straw Cut out three pieces of ribbon and tape to back of star

Now you have a shooting star!
