The babies on the bus go "Wah wah wah." All day long!

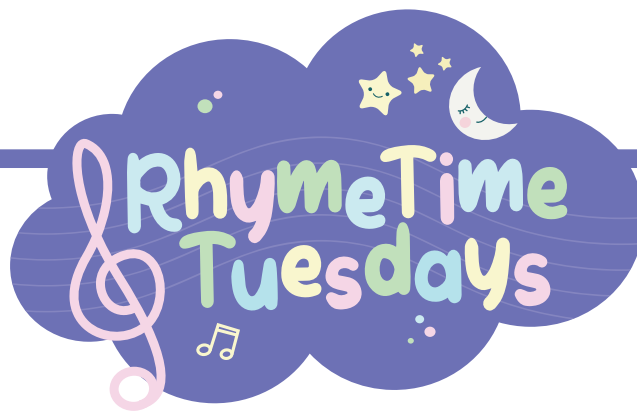
The people on the bus go "Shh ssh ssh, ssh ssh ssh, ssh ssh ssh."

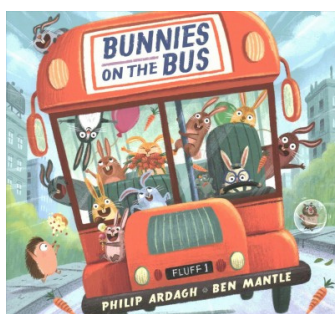
