

**BOOK:** I am Jim Henson

**AUTHOR:** Brad Meltzer

**ACTIVITY:** Make a sock puppet

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- (I) Fold the cardstock and draw a semi circle on it. The width of the circle should be about the width of your sock. Cut out the semi circle.
- Take your sock and push the semi circle through the opening until it reaches the toe of the sock.
- 3. Push the fabric of the toe into the opening of the piece of cardstock. Stick your hand into the sock and make sure the mouth moves.
- Cut short or long pieces of yarn to make the hairstyle for your puppet. Tie them together in the middle. Trim the ends if needed. Glue your hair in place.
- Draw a black dot on two pom poms/cotton balls for eyes. Glue the eyes to the sock.
- 6. When your glue is dry, put your hand through the opening of the sock and have fun making your puppet talk.


