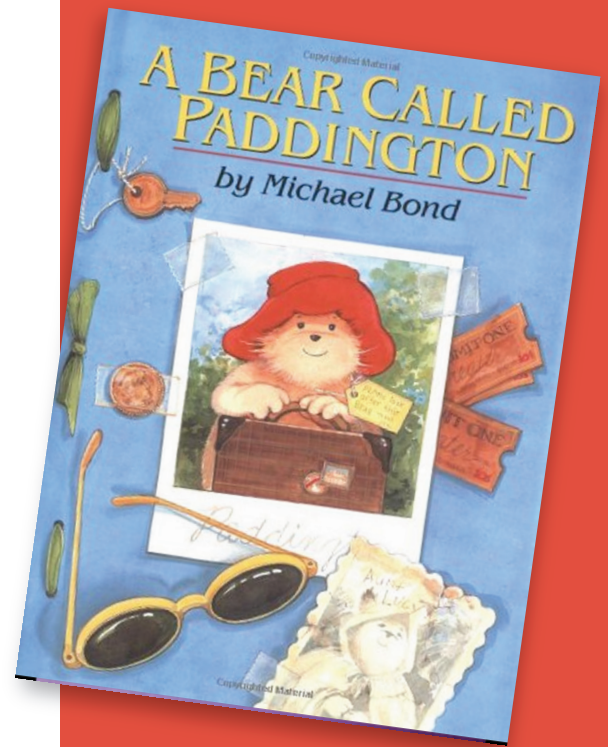
BOOK: *A Bear Called Paddington*

ACTIVITY: Make Paddington!

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Trim a piece of red paper into a 5.5 in. by 8.5 in. rectangle. Use these instructions to create your hat: <https://bit.ly/3yigvLO>
2. Glue down both corners of the hat and fold over the edge of the hat to give it a brim. Indent the top of the hat until it loses its point.
3. Glue the hat on a plain, brown toilet paper roll.
4. You can use blue fabric or paper to create the coat. The fabric should be cut into a rectangle piece that will wrap around the entire roll but not overlap itself.
5. Leave enough space to draw the face on the roll and glue the blue coat in place.
6. Cut a small triangle at the bottom of the roll for the feet. Draw three little lines on each side in black pen for toes.
7. Draw Paddington's face with black pen:
8. Using beans or buttons, glue two onto the seam where the blue material meets itself. Let dry.



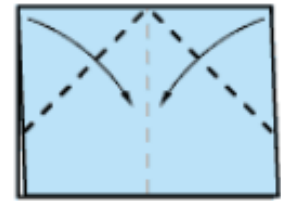
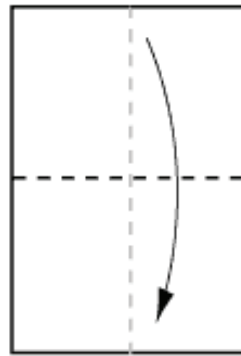
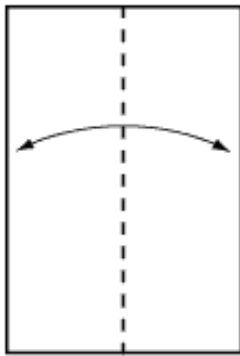
SUPPLIES:

- Two small buttons or beans



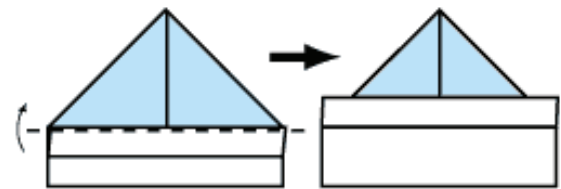
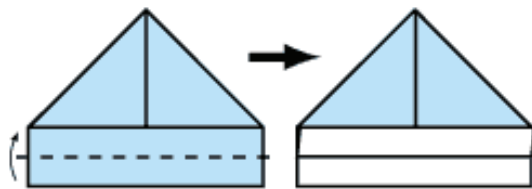

Simple Hat Instructions



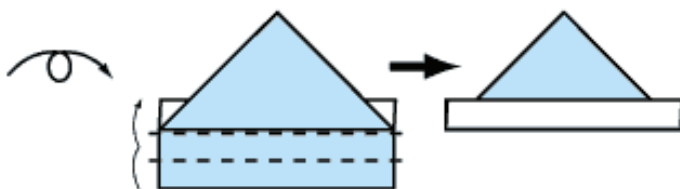
1. Start with a rectangular piece of paper, white side up. Fold the paper in half and open.
2. Now fold the top down to the bottom edge. Crease well.

3. Fold the top corners down to the centre line.



4. Fold the bottom edge (uppermost layer only) up to the base of the triangles.

5. Fold this part up once again, and crease well.



6. Turn model over, and repeat step 4 & 5 on the other side.

7. Open out the hat to shape it, Your hat is now finished!
